## ***Patriot Field Tournament Saturday October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011***

### **Itinerary:**

**9:30 am:** Students arrive at Patriot and load all food/field tournament items. Some students will go to Rubidoux HS to unload truck. Truck will return to pick up all band equipment (instruments, uniforms, etc). All students have drive or who have parents/guardians working the early shift please meet at Patriot and drive to Rubidoux once everything has been loaded. We will also need to take as much ice as we will need. The PHS custodian will be around at 10:00, mellophones and freshmen trumpets please load up all of our ice chests and big water jugs with ice.

**10:00am:** Custodian arrives at Rubidoux. Gates are opened, the snack bars and stadium will be unlocked and parents and students will begin setting up snack bar, hospitality and everything else.

**10:00-12:15** set up time.

**12:15** Band and guard get your equipment and head to the field. Do a quick stretch and be ready by 12:30 to begin rehearsing. That means you're on the field ready to practice. Pit be ready by 12:15 (so start moving stuff at about 11:55)

**12:30-2:30** band and colorguard rehearsal (**wear a white t-shirt and practice with shakos ON**) This is when we'll need adult helpers in full force, the entire PCR will be rehearsing and preparing for the night performance.

**2:30-3:00** Band/guard/ drumline: Set up our storage area by the "loop" near the stadium. Line up instruments, uniforms, shakos, and everything else... NEATLY. We will need 1 adult to watch our equipment the entire day.

**3:30** Everyone is working jobs, students are wearing browns on top, black pants, and black shoes (marching shoes if you don't have all black shoes.).

**4:30** Gates Open

**5:50** head to our area and change. (Be QUICK!)

**6:20** quick stretch/vis. Warm up

**6:50** music warm-up . Mr. Moreno with the band until the end of the performance.

**7:15** Run some ensemble music sections with full group

**7:35** leave for the gates (pit at 7:30)

**7:45** At the gates

**8:00** Patriot Performance

**8:15** Done with the performance. Band and colorguard change back into travel uniforms with black Patriot shirts on top. Load all instruments and equipment back onto the truck and trailer.

**8:30-9:00** Awards. Drumline plays cadences as drum majors and captains march on the field. Steven, and 6 captains give out awards. The rest of the group changes out of uniforms and starts to clean up around school:

## Clean Up Schedule

**8:30-9:00** all students go around the inside of the Rubidoux campus and pick up any and all trash. Leave nothing behind. Everyone have a trash bag.

**9:00-9:30:** Brass clean up the bus parking lot. Woodwinds clean up the spectators parking. Drumline and guard clean up the stands. By clean up I mean pick up all trash and make sure the entire area is clean as if no one had ever been there.

**9:30-10:00:** Guard helps to clean area around hospitality (the visitors snack bar). Woodwinds help to clean up the snack bar and outside area. Brass cleans around the track. Percussion cleans area from the snack bar to the stadium. Also, help to load anything that needs loading.

**10:00** Head back to Patriot. Unload trucks/trailers/other vehicles. Put everything away.

**10:45** Approximate pick up time. (it may be later or sooner depending on the amount that needs to be cleaned and loaded... as well as how quickly we can get everything cleaned, packed up, and unloaded.

### **Students Remember:**

**Leaders and upper classmen please lead by example and help to make sure that EVERYONE is working the entire day and that EVERYONE helps to clean up.**

**-Bring all of your equipment, shirts, instruments, etc.**

**-Organize everything the night before so that it is ready to go on Saturday morning.**

**-Don't be late Saturday (like last week), plan accordingly so that you can arrive on time.**

**-Do not look for ways or places to disappear to. Do not make us look for you and find you.**

**-If you're not busy, ask the adults if they need help with anything. Stay busy!**

**- You can leave your backpacks on the truck for the day. There will be someone watching it all day. Please do not leave anything valuable (money, ipods, phones, etc) though.**

**- Put your names on your shirts and Patriot clothing! Clothes get mixed up and lost all the time so put your name or initials on all clothing to avoid confusion. If you lost it you will have to buy another one.**

### **Everyone Remember:**

**Be courteous. This is a big fundraiser for us and one rude student or adult helper can cause a group to NEVER come back (and this has happened). Please be helpful and nice. Every student, spectator, staff member, and director is a GUEST at our tournament and we want them to have a good experience. Don't forget to have a good time and not to stress out about little things. Just remember that if anything goes wrong (and things will), that life goes on and everything will be okay!**
